6/2/2016 Corporal Hartley investigated a report that two men in Kingfield had furnished alcohol and marijuana to two juvenile females at a Mill St. apartment in Kingfield. After conducting interviews with the victims and one of the suspects, Hartley arrested Scott McLean (24) of Kingfield for Aggravated Furnishing of Scheduled drugs Class C, Furnishing liquor to a Minor Class D and Furnishing a place for a minor to consume or possess Class D. McClean bailed for \$1000 cash the same day. The case is still open pending contact with the other male who was involved.

Deputies conducted 100 building checks during this time period, two were found unsecure; Deputies also conducted 15 elder checks.
