Weekly Report – May 6th – 13th 2016

5/7/2016 Deputy Doucette and Corporal Hartley responded to Barker Rd in New Vineyard to remove a male from a residence there because he was intoxicated, disruptive. He was transported to FMH for a mental health evaluation and was also summonsed for violation of conditions of release.

5/7/2016 Deputy Doucette and Corporal Hartley were requested to respond to Industry Road in Industry where a juvenile was out of control and assaulting his sister. Because both deputies were tied up with a complaint in New Vineyard and State Police was also tied up with another complaint, Somerset County Deputies responded to the Industry complaint to assist.

5/7/2016 Deputy Doucette responded to assist Jay Police with a suicidal person in Chisholm.

5/8/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to a car vs. deer accident on the Rangeley road in Avon. The deer died at the scene, the car sustained reportable damage.

5/8/2016 Deputy Morgan and Corporal Brann responded to Zions Hill Rd in Chesterville regarding a report of a domestic disturbance and a suicidal person with a handgun. The complainant reported that her husband was at his residence alone threatening suicide because she was going to leave him. Investigation revealed the husband did not want to harm himself.

5/8/2016 Deputy Doucette investigated a report of vandalism to a window on the Basin Road in New Vineyard.

5/8/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to a domestic dispute on School St in Kingfield. Upon arrival he discovered that a couple had been involved in a verbal domestic however both parties denied that any physical contact was made. Morgan was assisted by Trooper Hall and Officer Reed from CVPD.

5/9/2016 Deputy Doucette conducted a welfare check on a man walking on the Ridge Road in Chesterville who appeared to be in some sort of distress. He was found to be OK.

5/9/2016 Detective Ken Charles investigated a DHHS sex crime referral which was reported in New Vineyard.

5/9/2016 Deputy Morgan investigated a 911 misdial complaint on the Phillips Rd in Weld.

5/9/2016 Corporal Brann responded to Prince Rd in New Sharon for a mental health emergency. A juvenile female was transported to FMH for an evaluation.

5/10/2016 Corporal Brann and Deputy Morgan assisted State Police in an attempt locate a person they were trying to find and reported to be on Cape Cod Hill Road.

5/10/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to a 911 hang up complaint on the Avon Valley Rd in Avon. The caller was intoxicated when she called after midnight but no emergency was found. The same female called back at 5pm later on that same day and claimed to be suicidal. Corporal Brann responded to the residence to find the caller intoxicated again but claiming she was not suicidal and just wanted someone to talk to. Later on she was transported to FMH for an evaluation.

5/10/2016 Corporal Brann responded to Storer Drive in Chesterville to what was initially called in as a juvenile offence. A male caller called to complain that a juvenile would not leave his house. Investigation revealed that the child is a friend of the complaints children. Upon arrival Brann found the child's mother there (who is a friend of the complainant's girlfriend). The complainant was intoxicated which appeared to be most of the problem. The child left with his mother.

5/10/2016 Deputy Morgan assisted Farmington Police with an incident at the request of staff from FMH.

5/10/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to a suspicious incident complaint on the Maxwell Road in Weld. The complainant claimed that someone is flying a drone in the area of his residence and his neighbors.

5/10/2016 Deputy Morgan investigated a harassment complaint on the New Vineyard Road in New Vineyard. The female complainant reported she is being harassed on Facebook.

5/11/2016 Corporal Bean responded to a single vehicle accident on the Industry Road in New Sharon. No injuries were reported.

5/12/2016 Chief Deputy Lowell responded to a single vehicle accident on the Rangeley Road in Avon. No injuries were reported.

5/12/2016 Corporal Brann investigated an alleged assault in Strong.

5/13/2016 Detectives Ken and Stephen Charles assisted State Police in an attempt to locate a suspect in New Sharon regarding a temporary warrant issued by Trooper Hall.

Deputies conducted 25 building checks during this time period, one was found unsecure; Deputies also conducted 4 elder checks.
