Weekly Report – April 8th – 22nd 2016

4/8/2016 Corporal Bean and Deputy Scovil responded to a report of a home invasion on the Weld Rd in Phillips. The victim stated he was home sleeping in the evening when he was awakened by two males who were dressed in camouflage clothing, facemasks and gloves had entered his trailer. They assaulted him and then tied him up to a chair using duct tape and stated they would hurt him further if he did not give them any money he had, the victim turned over \$30 in cash he had in his wallet, as they left they threatened to return if he called the police. One man was described as being between 5'8" to 5'10", the second taller man was described to being close to 6'tall and both weighing roughly 150lbs. Detectives Stephen Charles, Ken Charles and Lt. St. Laurent responded to the scene to process it for evidence. The victim believes the men walked to his residence because he did not hear a vehicle. The case is still under investigation by CID detectives.

4/8/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to what was originally called in as a burglary on the Barker Rd in New Vineyard, however further investigation revealed that only a screen had been blown out of a window at the residence.

4/8/2016 Deputy Morgan assisted Wilton Police with a domestic disturbance on Main St. in Wilton.

4/9/2016 Deputy Doucette investigated a trespassing complaint on Mile Square Rd in Phillips, however it turned out that the complainant had been involved in the recent purchase/sale of a car and now the other party (who claim are the legal owners) were threatening to come onto his property to reclaim it. This is a civil dispute.

4/10/2016 Deputy Morgan responded to a 911 hang-up on the River Rd in Carthage. It was determined to be a misdial.

4/10/2016 Deputy Morgan investigated a complaint on the River Rd in Carthage. It was determined to be a civil landlord tenant dispute.
