2/28/2019 1210hrs, Deputy Morgan responded to a single vehicle accident on the Carthage Road in Carthage. No injuries were reported.

2/28/2019 1442HRS, Sgt. Brann responded to a report of an injured cat at a residence on Avon Valley Road in Avon. The complaint was forwarded to the town selectpersons.

2/28/2019 1933hrs, Detective Ken Charles concluded an investigation into a two complaints of a sex crimes which were alleged to have occurred at a residence in Carthage. The investigation started a week ago with a DHHS referral that alleged unlawful sexual contact during the summer of 2018 on a juvenile female under the age of 17. After finalizing the investigation, Detective Charles summonsed the suspect **Warren Strout (54) Carthage** for unlawful sexual touching. As a result of the investigation a second female also under is age of 17 came forward and disclosed a similar complaint. Detective Charles returned to the residence and after conducting interviews he arrested **Warren Strout** for Unlawful Sexual Contact class B and Violating Conditions of release class E because the second incident was reported to have occurred while Strout had bail conditions in place. Lt. St. Laurent assisted with the investigation as well as Sgt. Brann. Sgt. Brann transported Strout to jail.

3/1/2019 0100hrs, Deputy Doucette responded to the town of Jay at the request of the Police department for a K-9.

Deputies conducted 10 building checks during this time period all were secure, Deputies also conducted 8 Elder Checks.
